

Offa's Dyke - 2

5.2 miles

Please leave gates as you find them.



An extended walk to the Offa's Dyke.

This walk has steep inclines.

ROUTE INFO

Start the walk by reception, heading through the wooden wicket gate to the left of the Swimming Pool balcony.

Cross the field to join the stone road which heads uphill, keeping the fence line on your left-hand side.

Pass through 2 gateways and continue along the track until you have a white cottage above you on the left(Llandinship).

Keep on the road ahead passing through another gateway in to the 'Llandinship Meadow' field with the fence on your right-hand side.

Pass through another gateway and continue until the road crosses over the stream.

Head up the steep field directly in front of you, keeping the fence & newly planted hedge on your left.

Pass through a small wicket gate and rejoin the road to go through a gateway.

The road now heads uphill towards the Offa's Dyke.

Pass through another gate way and keep with the track heading uphill.

You will pass through another gateway on the way before the road becomes very steep.

When you reach the top, you will see the original Offa's Dyke footpath on your right and left (a big mound).

The Offa's Dyke stretches the whole length of Wales.

Right will take you to Knighton and South and left take you towards Newcastle On Clun and North.

Continue through a gateway and turn left with the road.

You will pass some sheep sorting pens on your right and a Dutch Barn on your left.

Continue through a gateway following the 'Ancient Drover's road' for approx. 1 mile passing a trig point in a field to your left (the highest point of the Offa's Dyke at 1209ft above sea level) and several gateways.

You will reach a small carpark. Turn left on the road heading down a steep hill towards a farm, The Green.

Continue down the lane until you reach a junction at a bridge, turning left over the bridge.
